- 3. Learning Model Update Bridges/Kindergarten Grade 6 attending *in-person* continues to go well. Mr. Bunn will present the Secondary transition plan to the Board at the February 16 School Board meeting. However, we are moving forward with plans to transition grades 7-8 to in-person learning four days a week beginning Tuesday, February 16. To prepare for the transition, a planning day for 7-8 staff is scheduled for Friday, February 12. Grades 7-8 will not have school on February 12.

5. Superintendent Search Process Update –Please note the dates below in the Calendar of Events. The March 1 special meeting starting time has been changed from 6:30 pm to 5:30 pm. The starting times for the March 9 and/or March 10 planned special meetings to interview finalists may change but now are planned to start at 5:00 pm. Looking ahead to the planned interviews on Thursday, March 4, Rick Schultz has been working with the SCSC consultants in putting together the Staff/Community Interview Team. At this time, the committee will include six (6) staff members, two (2) principals, four (4) community/parent members. The Board will interview candidates in one location that will also be open to the public and the Staff/Community team will interview the candidates in a different location and that will be closed to the public. The March 4 interview are planned to be held at the Elementary School based on space and layout. It has not been finalized whether or not virtual interviews will be an option.

Regarding review of applicants' files, Board members will have the opportunity to review all the application materials from each candidate. These will be delivered to the District Office by noon on Wednesday, February 24 and will only be available for review until 4:00 pm on Thursday, February 24. Board members need to schedule a 1-hour time slot with Sue Kulseth to review application materials. Available times on February 24 will start at 1:00 pm with the last appointment scheduled for 3:00 pm, and starting at 8:00 am on February 25 with the last appointment scheduled for 3:00 pm on February 25. The application review must be viewed alone and board members may not discuss any information in the applications with others. The application review is optional for Board members.

At the March 1 Special School Board meeting, the SCSC consultants will have a Candidate Booklet for each School Board member. The Candidate Booklets will have the recommended applicant materials for everyone to review prior to the Round One interviews scheduled for March 4.

At the March meeting, details regarding the March 4 interviews will be shared and finalized.
