We continue to live-stream the Board meeting via YouTube. Board members and essential staff will continue using *Google Meet* to access and participate in the meeting.

3. Virus Spread Impacting School Districts in Region – We are aware of several outbreaks in schools in the South Central Region. As of March 9, at least two schools in the region have had to move to distance learning for a temporary period of time due to the outbreaks according to our Regional Support Team coordinator. The number of positive cases in our zip codes have increased. As of Thursday, March 11, we are monitoring closely an increase in the number of students and staff reporting symptoms. A reminder that at any time, we will need to be ready to move some or all of our students to full distance learning for a temporary period of time (1 – 2 weeks minimum) due to positive cases, quarantines, and/or unable to adequately staff our schools. Let's hope that all students, staff and families will wear face coverings when around others, properly distance when one is able, wash hands often, and stay at home when ill.
