2. Secondary School Electronic Sign Replacement – Recently, I have forwarded two communications regarding potential grants/donations for the Secondary School sign replacement. I completed a grant request to the Waseca/New Richland Area Foundation and also sent a letter to the Freeborn County Oil Coop. In both requests, I included:

NRHEG Public Schools is in need of replacing the Secondary School electronic sign that no longer works due to the age. The software needed to run the sign is no longer able to be updated and the availability of parts are limited in order to perform any upgrades to our current sign. The cost to replace the sign is estimated to be in the range of \$35,000 to \$40,000.

Communication and marketing is one of six priority focus areas for the school district. The electronic messaging board is one tool the school district utilizes in engaging the community by communicating the important events happening in the school district. In order to be more efficient in our communication with the community, a larger display and easier access to control our sign is needed.

3. Elementary Principal Search Update – I had the opportunity to meet with more than 40 Elementary staff members on Wednesday of this week and then with parents on Thursday as they shared characteristics, attributes and traits they believe are important for the next principal to lead the Elementary School. The posting is open through March 31. I have been tentatively planning for interviews to take place the week of April 12, but might consider Wednesday, April 7, if ready.
