School Board Recognition Week

The Minnesota School Boards Association has set February 22-26 as Minnesota School Board Recognition Week to build awareness and understanding of the vital function elected school board members play in our society. NRHEG Public Schools is joining other public school districts from across the state to celebrate School Board Recognition Week to honor local board members for their commitment to the NRHEG school community and its students.

Strong schools help build strong communities and our school board devotes countless hours to making sure our schools are helping every child learn at high levels. School board members make the difficult decisions every month, and spend many hours studying education issues and regulations in order to provide the kind of accountability our citizens expect.

- Creating a vision for what the community wants the school district to be and for making student achievement the top priority;

Superintendent Search Process

South Central Service Cooperative (SCSC) is facilitating the Superintendent search process for the School Board. The process includes a Community Engagement Survey to be completed by going to the District website at https://www.nrheg.k12.mn.us/domain/725. The survey closes at the end of the business day on Tuesday, February 16.

The tentative timeline includes SCSC providing a candidate profile to the School Board on February 16 based on the survey results. At a special March 1 School Board meeting, the Board will determine candidates to interview. Interviews are tentatively scheduled for March 4. The School Board hopes to make a decision on a candidate by the March 15 School Board meeting.

A reminder that the School Board conducts its regular monthly meeting on the third Monday of each month beginning at 6:30 pm. Typically, the location of the meeting is rotated monthly between the NRHEG Secondary School Media Center in New Richland and the NRHEG Elementary School Media Center in Ellendale. However, until further notice, the School Board will hold its regular monthly meetings at the Secondary School Media Center due to "live-stream" technology requirements. The School Board intends to continue live-streaming regular School Board meetings at least through the COVID-19 pandemic period when restrictions are placed on the number of the public that may attend. The February 16, 2021, School Board meeting is scheduled on Tuesday due to a federal holiday. Until further notice, Board members have the option to attend the meeting remotely due to the COVID-19 pandemic. There will be a minimum of one Board member and myself at the designated site. All COVID-19 CDC safety guidelines will be enforced for any public attending.
