- 3. In the interim between election and assumption of office, the new member will have an opportunity to attend a Phase 1 training sponsored by the Minnesota School Board Association (MSBA). The Superintendent will attend the Phase trainings with the new Board member.
- 4. Prior to and/or immediately after the new Board member officially takes office, additional opportunities to participate in required Phase 1 & 2 trainings by MSBA will be offered including at the MSBA Annual Leadership Conference in January.
- 5. All Board members are encouraged to attend the MSBA Annual Leadership Conference.
- 6. Special appointments with the Superintendent and selected administrative personnel may be arranged to afford an opportunity for the new member to discuss specific operations functions of the School District.
- 7. Additional materials and resources will be provided to the new member as requested or believed to be beneficial.
