NRHEG School is supporting Steele County Public Health & Waseca County Public Health in offering voluntary COVID-19 vaccine clinics for children ages 5-11. There will also be vaccines available for 12+ and those requesting boosters at ELLENDALE ONLY.

The Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine has been authorized for use in children ages 5–11 years old by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
