


REPORT for 2022–2023 school year



Goal 1: All children are ready to start kindergarten

By September 2022, and continuing annually thereafter, 80% of students within our district boundaries will attend NRHEG preschool.

73% For the 2022-2023 school year, 43/59 kindergarten students attended NRHEG preschool or Bridges



Goal 2: Reading by 3rd Grade

By June, 2022, and continuing each year until 2024, the NRHEG 3rd grade reading scores will be at or above state average of proficiency in reading as measured by the MCA III Reading Assessments.


State average of proficiency in 3rd grade MCA III Reading Assessments




A. Elementary – 80% of students will increase their reading proficiency by one grade's worth of growth based on their Fountas & Pinnell Reading Level.

For the 2022–2023 school year, 160/219 elementary students increased their F&P reading level by one grade



B. Secondary – the secondary school will achieve a 20% decrease in the number of failing grades in grades 6–12.







C. All students – the gap between the F&R/SpEd students and the Non–F&R/SpEd will be reduced at a rate equal to or greater than the state average rate reduction.

F/R

The NRHEG achievement gap between students receiving F/R and those not is significantly smaller than that of the state in both Math and Reading MCA III scores.

SpEd

The NRHEG achievement gap between students receiving SpEd services and those not is significantly smaller than that of the state in both Math and Reading MCA III scores.

Goal 5: All Students will Graduate from High School


A. By June 2023, and continuing annually thereafter, NRHEG's 4-year graduation rate will meet or exceed the Minnesota State average.
