# Cheer Team All-Americans

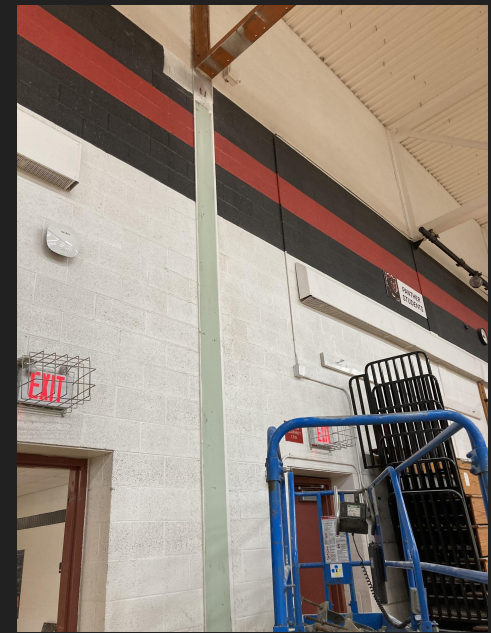

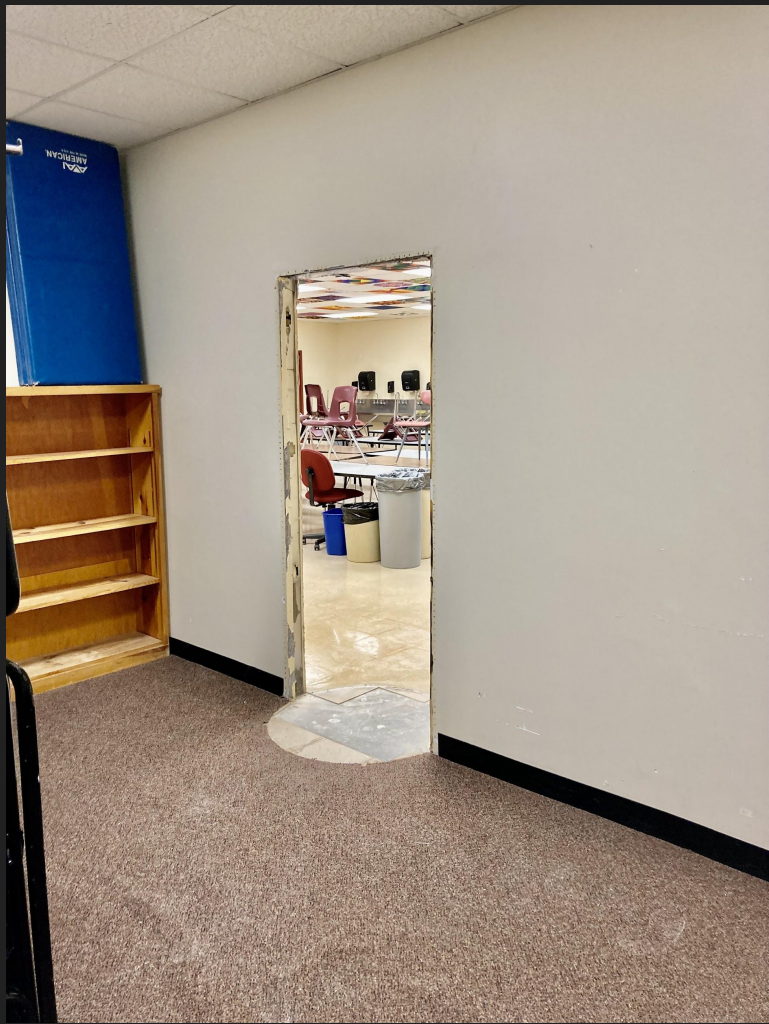

Wednesday Sept. 22nd from 3:30 to 6 pm

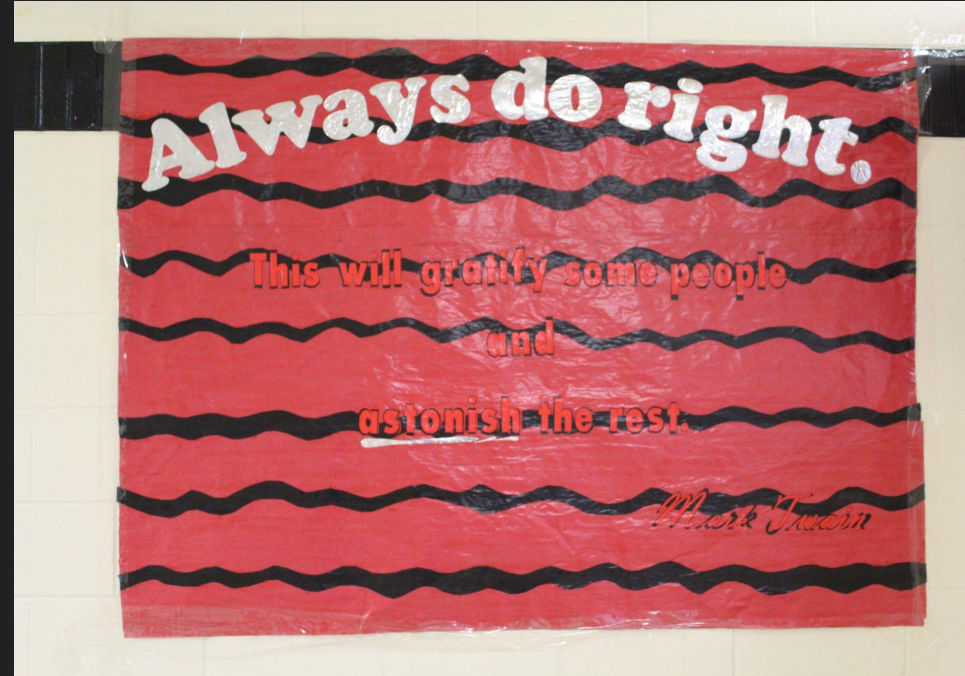


## From Mr. Domeier:
