2. District Van Purchase Follow-up — We have been searching for safety information on the Ford Transit T-150 Van specific to roll-over comparable data with other 7-passenger vans i.e. Dodge Grand Caravan. At this time, we have been unable to find comparable data from some of the more common automobile review and rating agencies i.e. JD Power, Edmunds, Car and Driver, etc. There are some reviews that do acknowledge the ongoing issue of higher incidents of rollovers, but somewhat inconclusive when comparing specifically the 10 passenger van.

We feel comfortable moving forward with the purchase especially based on the type of use planned for this van. At a time when we are ready to replace the next van in our fleet, we will reexamine the type of transportation use planned along with the current safety data available at that time to help us in determine what type of van will best meet our needs. Let me know if you have further questions.

- **4. Vaping Concerns** Mr. Bunn has reported an increase in students found to be "vaping" and/or in possession of vaping devices while at school. Our policy addresses smoking that includes vaping and ecigarettes. Mr. Bunn is working with local and county law enforcement officials to partner in an effort to decrease the incidents involving vaping. This week, Mr. Bunn e-mailed students and staff reminding them that the use of vapes in the building "will result in school discipline and/or punishment by law."
