- **5. Building and Grounds Committee to Meet** The Building and Grounds Committee will meet at 5:30 pm on Monday, May 21, prior to the start of the School Board meeting. The agenda includes:

- **6. Finance Committee to Meet** The Finance Committee will meet at 5:30 pm on Wednesday, June 6, beginning at 5:30 in the Board Room. The agenda includes:
 - Review Budget Development Calendar for 2018-2019 and 2019-2020
 - Review 2018-2019 Preliminary Budget
 - Examine Board Goal for Superintendent which is to: share progress made in integrating the finance committee into budget development process with the purpose of annually planning and managing revenue and expenditure budgets that meet or exceed the fund balance goal (Strategic Plan Finance Focus Area Objective 1C).
 - Examine/identify assumptions for 3 year forecast model
- **7. Facility Planning Task Force Update** The first two meetings have focused on providing the task force with a great deal of information beginning with a historical perspective of the Board's actions taken since the unsuccessful 2015 referendum. The focus of the second meeting was to provide information on the priority areas as determined by the Board with a primary focus on educational programming as well as safety.

Due to feedback received from a number of members at the second meeting, we are modifying our meeting plans and will be incorporating tours of each building on May 30. The evening will begin at the Elementary School at 6:30 pm with a presentation on programming areas (Secondary science rooms and fitness areas) as well as information on the egress issues with our Secondary locker room. We will then tour the Elementary School followed by traveling to the Secondary School for a tour before ending the evening. We are working on providing transportation for task force members that evening back and forth between sites.

Due to adding a meeting to focus on building tours, we will need to add a meeting for the task force most likely in July. Meeting #4 is planned for June 25 and will focus on having the task force prioritize or rank the program areas and other facility needs that have been presented. ISG will have cost estimates for that evening as well. For meeting #5 to be scheduled in July, the task force will be charged to assist in developing the community survey priority areas that will then be given to School Perceptions to finalize the survey. It is undetermined at this point when the survey will be ready to be administered but hopefully sometime in September. This would allow time for the task force to meet in early October to analyze results in order to make recommendations to the Board (perhaps at the October regular meeting or special work session) as it would need to make final decisions by November if there is interest in going to referendum in February.

The feedback received from the members following the two meetings has been overall very positive. A common theme has been that there is a great deal of information and some degree of feeling overwhelmed. This is another reason for adding another meeting.
