- 6. Bus Drivers and Cell Phone A Board member asked a question this week about our drivers using cell phones while driving. I responded with:

Karla Christopherson shared with me your question about bus drivers using cell phones while driving. We researched to see if there had been any changes as referenced in statute and/or the State Patrol Manual.

State Statute 169.443. Subd. 9(b) - **Personal cellular phone call prohibition** states: "A school bus driver may not operate a school bus while communicating over, or otherwise operating, a cellular phone for personal reasons, whether handheld or hands free, when the vehicle is in motion or a part of traffic."

Our drivers know and understand this requirement. Phone call use is limited to immediate/urgent communication that pertains specifically to their driving with the school district, and when possible, to use the phone while stopped in a safe location. This has been discussed among our drivers and we continue to be intentional in reducing the need for our drivers to communicate via phone while driving.
