2. Snow Day Relief Bill Update - This week, the House passed their snow day relief bill which allows a school district, if it chooses to do so, to count any canceled instructional days for January 29, 30, or 31 as instructional days. In our case, January 29 was an instructional day (Flexible Learning Day). January 30 \& 31 were cancelled days that have been rescheduled. The Senate bill allows districts to waive any snow day, if it chooses to do so. The differences between the two bills need to be worked out before going to the governor for his signature. Even if a bill is passed and signed by the governor, it will still be up to local school districts to determine if the district will lower the number of days and/or hours to be rescheduled.
3. Referendum Information Sessions Update - This past week, presentations were made to the Whispering Oaks Assisted Living. Thank you to Doug Anderson for presenting. At this time, I am not aware of any presentations planned for next week. So far, we have completed a total of 18 information sessions throughout our communities and townships beyond the open houses. Thank you for giving of your time to participate in the presentations. Please continue to update the sheet on information sessions shared with you. If you have confirmed with a group, please put the date and time down in the appropriate column and highlight it yellow. I would appreciate a call or e-mail so that I could get it on my calendar and possibly attend with you.
