- 6. Preliminary 2019-2020 Staffing Plan and Budget At the April 16 School Board meeting, the Board can expect to receive a preliminary staffing plan for the 2019-2020 school year. The plan will reflect adjustments driven by enrollment changes and course selection numbers At this time, we are preparing to present a staffing plan that reflects a projected reduction of about 28 students from Bridges/K through grade 12 when compared to student enrollment number used a year ago to determine the 2018-2019 staffing plan and budget. We also

plan to present a preliminary budget for 2019-2020 with the intention of having the Board consider adoption at the May Board meeting.
