No Bully School

The NRHEG District has applied for and received a \$15,000.00 grant to bring the NO BULLY SCHOOL Partnership to our school. ESPN and Major League Baseball have agreed to fully sponsor six schools within Minnesota for a NO BULLY School Partnership in the 2018-2019 School Year. The NO BULLY program is an integrated series of interventions for schools to implement to prevent and stop student bullying and harassment. The NO BULLY program brings schools in to compliance with state and federal anti-bullying mandates and aligns well with Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS). Both the secondary and elementary sites will develop a Leadership Coaching Team. Training will be provided to the team members and a foundational training will be given to all school staff.
