- Curriculum limited due to inadequate space
- Safety Issues due to inadequate space
- Focus on fitness and wellness

Secondary Facility Condition

- Disabled Access and Exiting code compliance issues for lower level
- Improvements to achieve indoor air quality standards
- Disabled Access for all restrooms
- Building Exterior Maintenance
