

*Be a role model. Experience has shown that children will react to and follow your reactions. We all know that they will learn from our example.

*Be aware of how you talk about COVID-19. Your discussion about COVID can increase or decrease your child's fear. If true, remind your child that your family is healthy and you are going to do everything to keep loved ones safe and well.

*Demonstrate deep breathing. This is a valuable tool for calming the nervous system. Practice this with your children.

*Focus on the positive. Celebrate having more time to spend as a family.

*Establish and maintain a daily routine. Keeping a regular schedule provides a sense of control. It also helps children and other family members respect others' need for quiet or uninterrupted time.

*Let your children's questions guide you. Answer their questions truthfully, but don't offer unnecessary details or facts.

*Correct misinformation. Provide developmentally appropriate facts that will help to reduce fears.

*Practice daily good hygiene.
