They are working hard at social distancing, are now pros at sanitizing upon entering the building (gloves were a new challenge this week) and continue to adjust to the "A"/"B" and Distance Learning schedules. Our school staff also continue to work extremely hard at supporting the needs of all learners while teaching full time to a group of students. Do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher should you have concerns regarding your child.

Our elementary students are given recess for 25 minutes every day, so it is very important they dress for the unpredictable winter weather. Please be sure to send snow pants, boots, winter jackets, hats, mittens, gloves, scarves. Elementary school general guidelines for recess during the winter is zero degree temperature including wind chill. Weather conditions will vary from day to day and one minute to the next, therefore, the building principal (or designee) will ultimately be responsible for determining outside or inside recess.

It is important that students are prepared each day as the weather starts out very cold in the morning and often warms up in time for recess. We believe it is important for children to get outside for exercise and fresh air every day, but ultimately their safety is our main priority. Students will not be allowed to go outside unless they are dressed appropriately for the conditions. Thanks! Mr. Anderson
