Final decisions have not been made yet, but here is a quick peek at what our plans are for the next school year.

The burning questions that so many are wondering are dealing with masks being required or not. As of today, July 30th, 2021, the NRHEG School District is planning to enter the 2021-2022 school year with the following measures in place:

- Students and staff will be encouraged to wear masks according to their personal comfort levels. Masks will not be required to be worn with the exception of while using school transportation. Federal transportation requirements are in place which includes school busses and vans.
- Socially distancing students at least 3 feet whenever possible. Lunches will be in the cafeteria understanding that some sort of seating charts may be needed to ensure 3 feet socially distancing.
- School will be in session according to our district calendar posted on our website. All school days will operate under our normal start and end times, no shortened days are scheduled for COVID-related reasons.
